

The Application

- •Must state:
 - 1. Nature and degree of alleged *incapacity*
 - 2. Whether alternatives were considered and whether they are feasible

- Value of the Estate
- Supports and services
- •Term of the guardianship
- Names and contact information for next of kin


Healthcare Certificate of Mental/Medical Exam



- Who may examine the proposed Ward?
 - Medical Doctor (licensed in Texas)
 - Psychiatrist
 - Pschologist (just added in 2023)
 - Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (MD must sign off)
 - •NOT Physician's Assistant Texas Estates Code 1101.103

Types of Guardianships

- Guardian of the Estate
 - Manages the financial affairs
- Guardian of the Person
 - Manages the medical and care decisions




Duration of Guardianships

- **Temporary Guardian** (Emergency Proceeding)
 - "Substantial evidence of incapacity"
 - Probable cause that person and or estate would become impaired if guardian not appointed
 - Appointment within 10 days of filing
 - Expires in 60 days


Permanent Guardian

- Person is not able to manage finances or care
- 4-6 to establish
- Remains in effect until Court order terminates or death



Priority of Serving as Guardian

- Spouse
- Parent
- Next of Kin

- 1. Register with JBCC (TGC 155.151)
- 2. Online Guardianship Course (TGC 155.20
- 3. Criminal Background check
 - 1. No felonies (TGC 155.205)
 - 2. No crimes of moral turpitude
 - 1. Theft
 - 2. Fraud
 - 3. Theft by Check
 - 4. Forgery
 - 5. Identity Theft
 - 6. Perjury and...



Qualification

- 4. Personal Representative Form
- 5. Court Instructions Form
- 6. Oath
- 7. Bond



The Hearing

- •Must prove:
 - BIOW
 - No alternatives



- Person to be appointed is "suitable"
- Incapacity (partial or total)





<u>Guardianship</u>

- Guardian must take Oath and Bond
- Tips on Bond
 - Safekeeping Agreements
 - Move Funds to Guardianship Friendly Bank
 - Keep the PODs when accounts are moved
 - Must bond for all income and liquid assets (not refunds)



I Care A Lot



- 1. <u>Inventory</u> Guardian must file a list of property within 30 days of qualification
 - (may require an appraisal)
 - include VIN for vehicle
 - include claims
 - Maybe use "Affidavit in Lieu of Inventory"

2. **Publication** – The Guardian must notice all creditors by publication of the appointment of a Guardian Texas Estates Code 1153.001(a)(1)

3. Monthly Allowance –

The Guardian must request permission from the Court on what funds are spent each month





4. Investment Plan

- The guardian must seek permission from the Court to invest funds of the estate
- Current investments can be maintained for 1 year
- Do it at your own peril

- a. Application
- b. Order
- c. Report
- d. Decree



- Keep all check stubs


Maintain a check register

Closing a Guardianship

- 1. File a Final Accounting
- 2. File a Final Report
- 3. Waiver of Notice from Ward/Executor
- 4. Discharge Guardian bond





Roles of the Guardian




- Advocate
